Wolverton Mountain Gun Club Shooting Campout

Please join us for our annual campout at Wolverton Mountain Gun Club beginning on Friday night 10/31, ending on Sunday 11/2. This is a Troop 320 favorite so plan on attending this fun event to learn more about gun safety and sharpen your skills.

You may bring your own firearms if your parent is attending. The firearm must be locked and in their vehicle when not in use on the range. WA State legal firearms only.

Cost is \$15.00 per person attending. This will cover range fee and some ammo.

Ammo will be available for purchase for the various firearms.

If you bring your own shotgun ammo there will be a per box charge of

\$2.00 to cover clays.

The following Long Guns will be available:

- Shotguns in 12, 20, & 410 gauge
- Rifles in .22 long rifle, .223 (AR type), .270, .30 Carbine, .30-30, .308, 30.06 (Garrand), 7.62X39 (SKS & AK) 300 Win Mag, 7.62X54R, 44-40 lever, .45acp, 45long colt
- The following Pistols are planned to be available: .22lr, 9x18mm, 9x19mm (para), 7.62x25 38 special/.357, .44-40, .44mag, 45acp, 45long colt.

Archery will be open to work on merit badges. Bring your equipment or make arrangements for equipment to be there. Be prepared for any type of weather.
